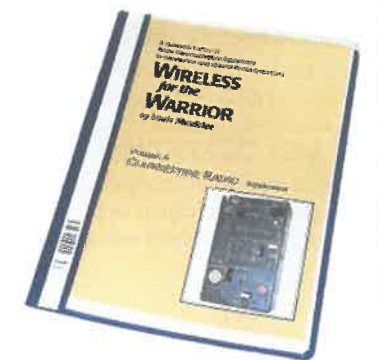
Also dependent on incoming material from the much respected contributors, it was seldom possible to put chapters together in a specific and logical sequence. This was quite clear when the WfW Vol. 4 Supplements series started with separate loose leaf chapters.

With nearly 300 chapters it became rather awkward to find back a specific chapter. It was Pete McCollum, N0TDM, who prepared an Excel file which allowed easy searching and sorting the 300 currently published chapters. For easy standard search a printable index was later produced.
